When to Apply How to Apply Application Follow Up Checking Award Status Student Responsibilities

Students must apply beginning October 1, and prior to August 31 of the high school graduation year, or forfeit all future eligibility for a Bright Futures Scholarship.

Award Types:

- Florida Academic Scholar (FAS)
- Florida Medallion Scholar (FMS)
- Florida Gold Seal CAPE Scholar (GSC)
- Florida Gold Seal Vocational Scholar (GSV)

In addition to general eligibility requirements, each award has different benchmarks to meet (subject to change with Florida legislative session):

- Courses
- Grade Point Average
- Volunteer Service Hours, Paid Work Hours, or 100 Hours combined
- Test Scores (ACT®/CLT®/SAT®/PERT)

Create a Student Account, and Complete the *Florida Financial Aid Application*

After submitting a *Florida Financial Aid Application* online, you can:

- Update your demographic information as necessary
- Monitor your Financial Aid Recipient History (award status) online
- Update your institution of choice

You are responsible for knowing and meeting the requirements of the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program before, as well as, throughout your college career, which includes test taken and completing the application by August 31 after high school graduation.

Check your application and award status on a regular basis.

Make sure that your demographic information is kept up to date on your application.

Keep your institution of choice selection updated. This is where your Bright Futures Scholarship award money will be sent.
